AW Tozer in his book *The Dangers of a Shallow Faith* said; “I firmly believe that true faith rises in the soul of the man or woman who will fall on his face before an open Bible and allow God to be God in his life.”

Throughout the history of the Church, God’s people have been led astray by spiritual complacency, misconceptions of what salvation involves and what it means to have faith in God.

The letter of James emphasizes the practical expressions of true faith in our life and perseverance in the midst of trials. The apostle James confronts the early Jewish believers on their shallow faith seen in their worldly pursuits, showing favouritism to the rich, paying lip service to God, etc. He differentiates between living and dead faith and elaborates on the marks of authentic faith. He warns in James 4: 4 that “friendship with the world is enmity with God.” Are we living as or drifting towards becoming “friends of the world”?
