SCRIPTURE VERSE

Lent 2022 begins on Wednesday, 2 March, and ends on Thursday, 14 April, a day before Good Friday on 15 April and Resurrection Sunday on 17 April.

Lent is a season for reflection to take stock of our spiritual life and to renew our commitment to the Lord. During this period, we discipline and humble ourselves before the Lord in prayer, fasting and repentance of our sins.

In the Holy Week, as we commemorate Good Friday and celebrate Resurrection Sunday, we will again be reminded and strengthened by our Father's love and power shown in the suffering, death and resurrection of His Son Jesus, our Lord.

The 7 “I Am” Statements of Jesus

The gospel of John was written primarily to 1st century believers who had forgotten or misunderstood who Jesus is because of false teachings at that time. The apostle John was concerned about their fallacies about Christ and wrote the gospel to remind the early Christians who Christ truly is and what He had come to do in this fallen world.

Unfortunately, the Church today also faces the same problems as the Early Church; many believers either do not know who Jesus is or hold misconceptions about Him. Some think Jesus is just a prophet, a great teacher, a miracle worker. There are also Christians who reject Jesus’ divinity and resurrection, seeing Him as no different from the founders of other religions.

The 7 “I am” statements of Jesus, unique to the gospel of John, give us a glimpse of the character of Jesus and the life-transforming work He had come to do in the lives of those who believe in Him.

Beginning Feb 6th to April 3rd, we will look at each of the self-claims of Jesus, exploring the significance of each truth and the difference it should make in our lives and faith. May I encourage you to read the appointed bible texts and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal God’s truth to you even before the sermons.

Weekly Devotions: THE REFINING FIRE OF TRIALS 16

Come to Jesus and You will Find Peace

In the last 35 years because of my cancers, I have had doctors telling me that I was going to die; that I would eventually go deaf and blind and lose the ability to swallow. In the face of bad news, what I need most is peace, an inner calm and confidence that though my world has collapsed around me, there is no need to be anxious or afraid.

But where do we go to get this peace without which we are likely to plunge into the abyss of depression or insanity? Peace is not something we can buy off the shelves or order online. Peace is also not something we can devise or produce. The One who can give us peace is the Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9: 6) and the only place to experience this peace is in His presence.

For me, spending time with our Lord reflecting on who He is and what He had done on the Cross always gives me a sense of hope, peace and even joy. After every medical test and consultation, I would head straight home to come into His presence. Picturing myself at the foot of the cross always gives me hope and the assurance that my Lord who had died for me will certainly help me.

Read John 14: 25-31; 16: 32-33

On the night of His arrest, Jesus told his disciples: *“Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.”* (John 14: 27) He was preparing them for what was ahead; He would be put to death, they too would be persecuted. He promised them His peace would be in their hearts. Jesus did not promise to keep the disciples from troubles, He promised to give them peace in their troubles.

The apostle John reiterated that the peace Jesus gave was different from the peace of the world. It is not the absence of problems but an inner calm in spite of external danger. This peace will sustain God’s people even in the midst of the worst troubles.

Questions to Ponder

1. What 2 things did Jesus promise His disciples (26-27) and how are they real in your life?
2. What are some reasons a believer may not experience God’s peace in troubled times and how can one experience God’s peace?
3. What did Jesus say about this present life and what assurance did He give us about life in this world (John 16: 33)? What sort of troubles do we face in the world as followers of Christ and how does Jesus’ promise encourage you?
